Hinders Learning

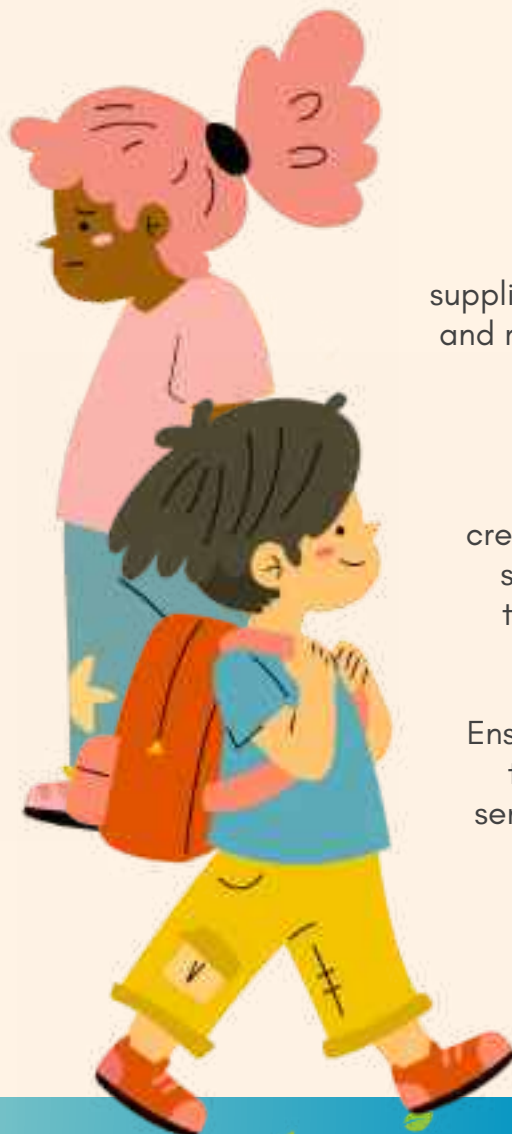
Insufficient tools hinder students' assignment completion and class participation, lowering academic performance.

Crumbles Confidence

Stressful Setbacks
